For you and your loved ones, the end of last year was a difficult one, especially for French citizens of the Island of Mayotte who was devastated by a tropical storm. Nearly €15,000 was raised, with effective help from the very first days, literally saving lives. That's what Solibad is also all about – providing emergency help when it's needed, and above all, when we know exactly where the funds we send are going.

The end of 2024 was also marked by other sad news, with the passing of our main ally and friend, the instigator of the YOMADO program in Rwanda Emmanuel, who died of diabetes on the evening of December 31... We pay tribute to him and think of him and his family.

But we have to keep up the good work, for his program as well as for others, in Madagascar, Indonesia, in our home of Bry sur marne, France, which we talk about in this newsletter, and others. Our aim is always to do the best we can, without taking ourselves too seriously, and to encourage the badminton community – of which you are often a part – to continue helping us. In a few weeks' time, the Solibad Days will be held from May 8 to 18. We encourage you to start organizing – time flies. With two main goals for this event: raise funds, but also have fun. Enjoy doing good. You'll see, it's the best way to get the year off to a good start.

with the badminton club of Bry-sur-Marne as the pilot project. The aim is to offer sports coaching to young people living in care or foster homes, thanks to Solibad's partner clubs. We cover the cost of membership fees, licenses and sports equipment. These children, from complex family situations and often marked by social difficulties, violence and traumas, find in badminton a way of building themselves and blossoming.

In 2023, Bouchra, a young girl from the Léopold Bellan children's home, was the first beneficiary of this project. Her personal development through sport has been a real inspiration, prompting us to extend the initiative to two other girls, Anaïs and Anna (photos below), who now play once a week in Bry.

Badminton offers them much more than just a moment's play: it's a powerful tool for developing their self-confidence, autonomy and social integration, while promoting their physical and mental well-being. "Since they started this activity, it's all they've talked about, and they've really blossomed on a daily basis," explains one of their educators.

This project is just the beginning: our ambition is to extend it to other clubs in France and abroad from next season, with homes close to them - and we're appealing to clubs wishing to make it a project next season.








NEWS FROM OUR OTHER PROGRAMS

Tribute to Emmanuel Nshimiyimana

It was with great sadness that we learned of the passing of Emmanuel Nshimiyimana, Executive Director of YOMADO, Solibad's partner association in Rwanda, within the framework of the Rays of Hope for Orphans and Vulnerable Children program.

The Rwandan community gathered to honor his memory and share his life story at the beginning of January.

The entire Solibad team is deeply touched by this loss. We share the grief of the Rwandan community and extend our deepest condolences to his family and loved ones. We remain in contact with the other directors of Yomado to ensure that our partnership continues, also in memory of Emmanuel.



A look back at our actions in Mayotte after Cyclone Chido

One week after tropical storm Chido hit Mayotte with devastating violence, Solibad responded to the appeal of Arnaud Génin, a former top-level badminton player, who called for help online, to help the families affected.

Solibad quickly released €2,000 of its own funds. Thanks to your donations, a further €13,000 has now been raised and used directly on the ground. This money has been transferred to Arnaud and his team of volunteers, enabling the purchase and distribution of basic necessities: rice, water, medicines and nutritious food.

The team took over the high school "Lycée des Lumières" (photo below), where dozens of families and children had taken refuge, and set up an efficient structure to manage waste, cleanliness and food distribution. This model initially inspired other centers in the region. Also, thanks to your contributions, a distribution of small gifts was organized on Christmas Day, for the children staying there, offering them a little happiness in this trying time.

In recent days, the inhabitants have returned to their homes – often in shantytowns where tin shacks have been recreated despite the insalubrious conditions. Arnaud and his friends have continued to distribute food and medicines in the shantytowns. The rest of the money collected is being kept for the time being, to be used in the event of a more permanent operation, following the emergency, with local associations, to benefit the families in the long term.






When Solibad program coordinators meet...
